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REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

- 1. The length of materials should be 2-3 pages.
- 2. Abstracts must submitted in the working language of the conference.

- 3. Use a4 sheet size;
- 4. Set the page orientation to portrait;
- 5. All margins should be 2 cm;
- 6. The text format must be microsoft word (.doc, .docx files).
- 7. Use times new roman font, size 14.
- 8. Set the line spacing to single (1).
- 9. Indent paragraphs by 1.0 cm.
- 10. The reference list should comply with dstu 8302:2015 guidelines and be presented in alphabetical order.
